What does it mean to be his ambassador?

**DO YOUR SHARE.** Read Ephesians 4:15-16. Do you feel like everyone is doing his or her share of the ministry at Sunridge? Why or why not? How would our impact be different if everyone who attended church on Sunday did ministry every day of the week?

**LIKE.** Read 1 Corinthians 15:57-58. Whose work is it? How does remembering this truth keep us from finding our identity and value in the role we play verses the relationships we experience?
