- Feel free to stand or sit during our singing time and participate in **worship**.
- We receive an **offering** from our church family each week that goes to support our efforts both locally and around the world. If you are a guest, please feel no obligation to participate. We're just glad you've joined us.

Baptism

Our practice at Sunridge is to baptize people as soon as possible after they choose to follow Jesus. If you place your faith in Christ today, or you are a Christian who has never been baptized as a believer; we invite you to come forward at the end of today's service to learn more about baptism.
