Questions for Life Groups and Personal Reflection

**What's changed?**

Think back over the last ten years; what changes have you experienced vocationally, personally, spiritually? How has Sunridge changed over the last ten years? (or at least as far back as your history will take you!)

**Change's inevitability?**

Do you think change is constant? What observations about the inevitability of change do you find in the Bible? How do you feel about change? What is it about the changes you've experienced that you've enjoyed? Disliked? Do you see any patterns that parallel biblical characters?

**What is a Pharisee?**

What can you learn from your study bible about Pharisees? (Hint: look in the notes section) Also, read the following verses and make as many observations about Pharisees as you can. (Matthew 23; Luke 7:36-39; 14:1; Luke 18:9-14; Acts 5:34) How was it possible for these devout Jews to completely miss Messiah's arrival? Describe what you think a modern day Pharisee would look like?

**New wine vs. old wineskins.**

Reread Sunday's passage in Mark 2, paying particular attention to verses 21-22. What do you think is the new wine God is pouring into Sunridge? Your personal life? Your family? Your vocation? What changes must you make in order to "hold the new wine"? How can you maintain the elasticity in your life so you can hold as much of the new wine that God is pouring into you?

**What about the gospel?**

How does Jesus' statement in Mark 2:21-22 challenge your thinking about the gospel? In light of his remarks, are you sure of your salvation?
